1. _____ (initial) **I am paying in full in cash/check to receive a bonus gift at the resort.**
2. A \$400 per person **non-refundable/non-transferable deposit** is required to reserve your spot on the trip. Credit card number must be on file for auto payment due 60 days in advance of trip date. _____ (initial) Preferred Credit Card _____ (last 4 digits)
3. Any cancellation less than 60 days out will result in a 100% penalty-no refund.
4. If you cancel, we will do our best to find someone to fill your spot, but if we have any unfilled spots on the trip, we will fill those first before finding your replacement.
5. Each diver must have been diving within the last 60 days and have cold water diving experience with a minimum of 30 logged dives.
6. You will need all dive equipment, which includes a BC, safe second, & dive computer. We highly recommend being Nitrox certified.
7. **Each diver must have a safe second, whistle & safety sausage.** We highly recommend a Dive Alert and Nautilus Lifeline.

RENDEZVOUS DIVE ADVENTURES COVID-19 PLAN FOR 2022

Current protocol as of December 2021 – subject to change

The goal of this plan is to minimize the risk of exposure to COVID-19 for us, our guests, contractors, and community during our business operations. It is based on government requirements and DAN recommendations intended to keep you and your fellow divers safe while visiting our lodge.

Preparation:

- **Please plan for your trip.** Dive travel/cancellation and health insurance is highly recommended.
- No face, hand or bath towels will be available – please bring your own.
- Facemasks are mandatory in BC. Please bring facemasks and wear them whenever you are in proximity to others who are not part of your known circle.
- Please review the Covid-19 self-assessment form and report any symptoms of COVID-19 immediately.
- If any guest arrives presenting symptoms of COVID-19, they and anyone sharing their vehicle will not be allowed to board and their trip will be postponed/cancelled.

When you arrive:

- You will be met upon arrival and briefed on any new boat procedures by Peter. Before boarding he will require your completed and signed Covid-19 Guest Information Sheet and will check your Vaccination QR code (if applicable).
- Once you arrive at the lodge you will be briefed on lodge procedures.
- Depending on current gov't regulations, facemasks may be required in any indoor space where social distancing is not possible. Please use proper disposal techniques when removing gear. - Hand sanitizer will be available at entrances and in dining area, and must be used in accordance with the briefing.
- When using the restrooms located within the lodge, please use the soap/hand sanitizer we have provided. Please clean sink and taps with provided supplies.
- Please don't leave your stuff lying around the lodge. Keep personal items in your room/camera room during your stay to reduce or eliminate potential exposure.

We cannot always maintain physical distancing while diving, but we can take other steps while on board:

- Be prepared to wear your facemask while inside the boat and anytime you cannot maintain 2m distance (depending on gov't regulations).
- Frequently wash hands with soap/water or use hand sanitizer available.
- Do not share your food, beverages, or utensils.
- Try to maintain at least 6 feet (2 meters) distance when clearing your nose, sinuses or throat at the surface or after a dive.
- Depending on supply availability/reliability of O2, nitrox fills may not be available.
- The kitchen area and refrigerator/freezer will not be available for guest use. Coolboxes with ice packs will be available.
- Kayaks (with paddles, life jackets etc.) will be available.
- The hot tub will be available if allowed.

At the end of your trip:

- Cleaning/rinsing your gear – dunk basins will be available for camera gear ONLY. All other gear is to be taken home to rinse unless otherwise arranged (smaller buckets for regs, etc). Boat will be sanitized daily, please help keep our team safe by disposing of your personal trash/recycling after your trip in provided receptacles. We request you wrap the trash from your guestroom.

Last but not least:

- For the health and safety of your dive group and those coming after you, please let us know *asap* if you or anyone in your party becomes ill within 14 days of your trip completion.
