CABIN OPTIONS



Premium Cabin #6 \$10,997 per person (Couples Only)

This Master Cabin is a massive 40 sq meters space with a king size bed (6.56 feet x 6.56 feet) and a narrow day bed (3.28 feet x 6.56 feet), 2 desks, reading lights and two bed side tables. It also has private walk out balcony and two separate compartments for shower and toilet. It's fully air-conditioned and have a flat screen TV that is pre-loaded a good collection of entertainment.



Premium Cabin #5 \$10,550 per person (Couples Only)

This Master Cabin is a massive 40 sq meters space with a king size bed (6.56 feet x 6.56 feet) and a narrow day bed (3.28 feet x 6.56 feet), 2 desks, reading lights and two bed side tables. It also has private balcony that is covered with glass windows and two separate compartments for shower and toilet. It's fully air-conditioned and has a flat screen TV that is pre-loaded a good collection of entertainment.



Standard Cabins \$9997 per person

These cabins vary in size from 215-269 sq feet, and are fitted with a double bed (5.25 feet x 6.56 feet) and a day bed (3.28 feet x 6.56 feet), desk, wardrobe, reading lights and bed side table. It's fully air-conditioned and has a flat screen TV that is pre-loaded with a good collection of entertainment. The en-suite facilities of dry and wet zone, of which the shower is divided with a glass door. Cabin #7 is either a king double bed (7.2 feet x 6.56 feet) or twin beds (3.6 feet x 6.56 feet each). It's located on the upper deck with direct access to the sun decks.



Waterfront Bungalows: Included in cabin pricing above

7 spacious and airy waterfront bungalows. Your bungalow is accessed via a private pebble path which leads to your tropical hardwood terrace and ocean front seating area. Inside, your bedroom features a full glass ocean facing frontage with either 1 king or 1 king + 1 single spring bed, air-conditioning, ceiling fan, wardrobe & computer desk. The en-suite open air bathroom with a fresh hot water rain shower provides an aerial view of the tropical forest canopy.

Flights: 2025--Depart from either Vancouver, BC (YVR) or SeaTac (SEA) to Jakarta (CKG) is best route.

- ~Depart on April 26/27 (depends on airline and departure time) to arrive in Jakarta on April 28.
- ~Overnight in Jakarta.
- ~April 29 take Garuda Airlines from Jakarta (CKG) to Ambon (AMQ)
- ~Overnight in Ambon.
- ~April 30 take Wing Air from Ambon (AMQ) to Saumlaki (SXK) to board the boat.

RETURN: Depart Alor (ARD) to Jakarta (CKG) or Bali (DPS) on May 17.

Depending on your International flight home from Jakarta or Bali, you might be able to return on May 17.
